

Research orientated internships at international organizations for the Master's programs FACT and DMSE

Students who participate in the Master's programs FACT and DMSE have the opportunity to spend several months at an international organization for a research orientated internship. Specialisations in the fields Finance & Insurance and/or Macroeconomics are desirable.

The internship is supported by a partial scholarship granted by the Staedtler Foundation. The scholarship is connected to the elaboration of a scientific project of which results have to be presented within a seminar after the internship. 5 ECTS will be granted for this seminar.

We are able to offer an internship to at least two students. We cooperate with the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (London, Great Britain) and the International Labor Organization (Geneva, Switzerland).

Those who are interested can apply until the **8th of November 2015**. Please hand in a CV in English, your bachelor transcript, the grades during your Master's degree, evidence of your English skills and a brief letter of motivation (also in English). Please send your application to christian.merk1@fau.de as well as to nadine.gatzert@fau.de. We also ask you to shortly summarize whether you have a preference for the EBRD or ILO, and if so, why.

A preliminary selection will be made jointly by Professors Nadine Gatzert, Christian Merkl and Hendrik Scholz. The best applicants will then be handed on to the EBRD and ILO where the final decision will be taken.
